Doors open at 9:00. Please do not drop your child off earlier than 15 minutes before this time as there will be no supervision before school hours. Students coming for breakfast may enter under the covered area behind the school at 8:45.

Winter WEATHER

IN THE EVENT OF BAD WEATHER, DISTRICT OFFICIALS WILL MAKE THE DECISION BY 5:15 A.M. THAT DAY TO CLOSE ALL OR SELECTED SCHOOLS OR TO DELAY THE START OF SCHOOL.

If schools are closed or start times ARE delayed, all students and staff will get a recorded message to the phone number on record with the district. This message will tell you about school cancellation, delay to start times, or district closure. Calls begin going out at 6 a.m. Make sure your contact information is up to date. Families who need to update their phone number should contact their school.

SCHOOL MESSENGER

At the start of each school year, information from student registration forms is input into the student information database.

SchoolMessenger, the system the district uses to send out phone notification to parents, receives updated information from this database once each day.

It is very important that parents keep their contact information current.

Be sure to let your school office know if you have a new address, email or phone number.

The parent or guardian marked as the primary contact in the student information system will receive automated communication.

Messages will also be sent to the student's home phone number contained in the database, if different from the primary contact phone number.

School District Gathers Community Feedback on Proposed Bond

The Salem-Keizer School Board is planning a general obligation bond measure for the May 2018 ballot. The proposed bond would address critical facility needs in nearly all schools and support buildings in our district.

In October and November, school district staff held Bond Listening & Learning Forums at each of the district's six comprehensive high schools. Parents, staff and community members in all school neighborhoods were invited to attend. The community feedback gathered at the listening forums was shared with the School Board.

The School Board is on track to finalize the bond package in January 2018. In the new year, there will be more opportunities for parents, staff and the community to hear about the bond measure.

Following are a few highlights of how the bond would benefit schools:

Construct additional space to address capacity issues, relieve overcrowding and address future enrollment growth.

Make seismic upgrades at schools rated very high risk for collapse in the event of a large earthquake.

Make safety and security improvements district-wide such as upgrading electronic badge access systems and relocating front office spaces for better visibility and control over who enters and exits school buildings.

Construct new Career-Technical/vocational education classrooms at all high schools to expand programs such as engineering, science and technology.
